

# 4DAYS 3NIGHTS DA NANG / HOI AN / BANA HILL

## **DAY 1: DA NANG ARRIVAL – HOI AN**

**(Dinner)**

Upon arrive at Da Nang Airport, meet and greet by local tour guide and transfer to **Hoi An** ancient town, which is located in central of Vietnam. Hoi An listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of Southeast Asia's main trading hubs from the 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> centuries. After dinner, proceed to Hoi An hotel for check-in.

## **DAY 2: HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN – BACK TO DA NANG**

**(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)**

After breakfast at hotel, discover **Hoi An ancient town** which are the famous **Japanese Covered Bridges**, the **Pottery Museum**, the 200 years old **Tam Ky House**, the **Chua Ong Pagoda** and the bustling market. We visit these sights on an exciting walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls which reflect the town's multi-cultural past. Lunch will be served at local restaurant. In the afternoon, transfer back to Da Nang and visit the **Cham Museum**, the **Non Nuoc Beach** and the **Marble Mountain**, whose peaks represent the five elements of the universe. Check in hotel for refresh. Dinner will be served at local restaurant.



## **DAY 3: DA NANG – BA NA HILLS**

**(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)**

This morning, depart to **Ba Na Hills**, pass by the sea-shore on Nguyen Tat Thanh Street, one of the most beautiful roads of Da Nang City and Red Beach, where the French first landed in Da Nang.

Arrive at the Cable car station and experience the Cable car ride, which achieves the Guinness World Records for longest non-stop cable car and highest non-stop cable car. Sitting in the cabin, in mid-air, looking upon the endless tree line of the forests, enjoy the spectacular views of the lush jungle and fairly waterfalls along the way. Visit the **Le Jardin**, **Wine Cellars** and **Ling Ung Pagoda** with 27m high Buddha status. After lunch, enjoy relaxing time at **Fantasy Park**, **French Villas**, **Peak of Chua Mountain** and stroll along at the **Golden Bridge** to enjoy the spectacular views. After that, return to the Cable car station at foot of Ba Na Hill then transfer back to Da Nang city. Upon arrival at Da Nang, enjoy shopping fun at **Han market**. After dinner, transfer back to hotel and rest.



## **DAY 4: DA NANG DEPARTURE**

**(Breakfast)**

After breakfast, check out from hotel, free at leisure until transfer to airport for departure flight.
